[C] Under [G] ground, [D7] under [G] ground

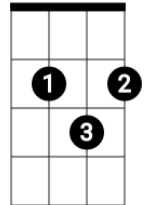

[C] Without [G] you, [D7] without [G] you

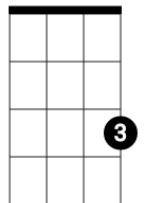
Final Chorus
