But to [F] cry-y-y-y [G7] over you [G7] *Ladies* (Cry over you)

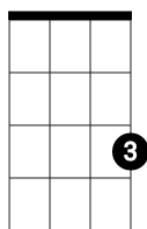

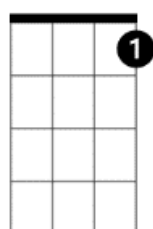

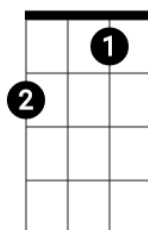
